



Minutes for the
Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference
Compliance Coordinators Conference Call

Wednesday, February 10, 2010
11 a.m.

1. Meeting was called to order at 11:02 a.m. Roll call was taken.
2. Sharon gave a brief update on her situation with the EC and the reversal of certification decisions on SAs. The EC at this point claims this could not have happened and say a notification is sent to make the institution aware that a change in certification has changed. In the future, all schools should make copies of everything and file with each SA.
3. Kathy brought up to the group that a junior college transfer can take an official visit without providing transcripts or being registered with the eligibility center. This was an informational piece that we might consider taking to the next level for clarification.
4. Tim wanted some additional clarification on Proposal 2010-3. The intent in the official notice was a two part segment, however on the NCAA website only the first part was listed. It is important to note, the information on the website was abbreviated and does not mean the second part was omitted from the passed legislation. In addition, it has been determined the legislation committee will review this proposal in more detail at their March meeting. Below was an interp Tim received from the NCAA that has also been passed on to the CCACA for review.

If an institution DOES NOT sponsor a sport, any personnel may arrange and run a tournament that involves prospects. (i.e. swimming coach develops and hosts a high school water polo tournament at a school that does not sponsor water polo).

If an institution DOES sponsor a sport, the personnel may now be permitted to work at such a contest but may not be involved in its organization, promotion etc. (i.e. Olympic Development Camp or high school program comes to school that has soccer to run a soccer tournament. Coach could now work the clock, registration etc. However, coach cannot organize and run their own soccer tournament for high schools).

5. Fran informed everyone that the EC wants to know from the membership what is working and what is not. In addition, is there anything on the old site that should also be included on the new one? Those who are still working with the old site are encouraged to make the switch.
6. Carey questioned the group as to which institutions have banner and if they have a bridge built. The NCAA has requested this information and Carlin will send out this information to all.
7. The date and time of the Compliance Call was addressed. Carlin will send out an email and request feedback as to what days and/or times are best for the group.
8. Additional Items:
Jeff brought up an issue with a JC who wants to get back a season after playing in only the non-championship season.

Jeff also mentioned that he felt the NCAA fines for playing an ineligible player were too steep. Fran said she will bring this up at her next management council meeting.

The PSAC will host another Compliance Seminar this spring. More information will be available soon.
