1. Meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m. Roll call was taken.
2. Todd gave us an update on his PTD Waiver from the last call. The waiver was received because it was classified as a student welfare issue. However, Edinboro had to create and implement a written certification policy. Todd must follow up with CC's no more than one week after the paperwork has been sent.
3. Todd also wanted to give the group an APC Reminder and to also mention that when each school files their APC to check with Maria to make sure it is received. Submit early and follow up. In addition there is NO extension this year. Carlin will follow up with CCACA to ask about extension.
4. Fran brought up the fee issue again with the EC and if a PSA is considered registered. There were conflicting answers from the EC at one point. A PSA is not considered registered unless they have paid the fee or have a waiver. The waiver must be filled out by the high school. An NLI cannot be issued unless the fee is paid.
5. Fran updated the group that no Question & Answer document will be available at the NCAA Convention. It will be available online January 6th. It was also received by the conference office and distributed to the members. An updated Life in the Balance document will be emailed on or around November 20th.
6. Carlin reminded the group that all interps should be submitted via email to the conference office for documentation purposes. There should be no phone calls made to get an interp unless it is for follow up.
7. Other Business:

Steve referred us to an email from the EC about submission of final transcripts for early academic qualifiers. Please be reminded you must submit a final high school transcript to the EC by November 15th following a SA's initial full-time enrollment for any SA who is certified as a qualifier pursuant to the early academic certification exception. Refer to Bylaw 14.3.1.1.1.1.

Fran wanted to confirm that a medical hardship or medical absence waiver would still be applicable to a SA if they transferred. Carlin verified that these waivers follow a SA throughout their career.
