1. Meeting was called to order at 10:01 a.m. Roll call was taken.
2. Steve Roach informed the group that his ATC had written to The National Center for Drug Free Sport (Drug Free Sport) about Gatorade G3 Recovery drink. Carlin followed up with Jenn Fraser and the following statement has been issued.

According to the Center for Drug Free Sport Gatorade G3 has a high percentage of protein. Due to the high percentage, institutions may not provide the supplement to student-athletes under Bylaw 16.5.1-(h) (nutritional supplements). At this time, the drink does not appear to be a banned substance.

If a member school wants a formal review, they need to provide the label of the product to Mary Wilfert. So not to inundate Mary with G3 labels, please have one conference submit the label for review and share the findings with all other conferences. I will be happy to assist with the coordination of that process.

3. Carlin reminded the group that Medical Hardship / Absence Waivers are due to the conference office by Friday, September 17.
4. Additional Items

Todd asked if anyone had heard of the Golf Academy and if any student-athletes at other institutions had used semesters earned at institutions such as these as a part of their 10 semesters. An associate's degree earned at an academy such as this would not be considered an academic degree and should not be counted in his/her 10 semesters. Bylaws 14.02.3 & 14.5.4.4.4 – An academic degree, rather than a vocational or technical must be earned.

Fran asked the group when each institution certifies (paperwork) their Track & Field teams. Most certify prior to the beginning of the season or prior to tryouts.

5. There will be no October conference call as the group will be meeting in person at the Fall Athletic Administrators meeting on October 5. Carlin will be requesting topics for that in-person agenda. The next call will be on Wednesday, November 10, at 10 a.m. The call was adjourned at 10:20 a.m.
