Minutes

Coaches Present: Peter Coughlin, California University; Marty Rinker, Clarion University; Ryan Paris, Gannon University; Fred Joseph and Dr. Frank Condino, Indiana University of Pennsylvania; John Marchetti, Mercyhurst College; Scott Vandergrift, Millersville University; Harry Hammond, West Chester University; Steve Murray, Commissioner, PSAC

The discussion centered around the conference championship at Hershey Links Golf Course. Mr. Murray mentioned that both the men and women would play on the same course at the same time. One group would go off #1 and one group would go off #10. There was mention about two different courses but it was not in the contract for this year. Further comments addressed the possibility of a Monday extension in case of rain, but it had not been placed in the contract. Mr. Murray said he would look into it. If rain became a factor and there was no Monday play then reference to the Operating Code III – F was discussed. A champion may be declared with a minimum of 18 holes played.

There was a revision of the Rules Committee make up. It was recommended that four USGA officials along with the host golf professional comprise the Committee.

Coach Marchetti brought up the possibility of moving the championship to another site in the future. Mr. Murray said that an alternate site is a topic that must be discussed at least a year in advance.
