

PSAC WOMEN'S GOLF COACHES ANNUAL MEETING

Conference Call

August 31, 2011

Minutes

1. Coaches discussed the possibility of moving the championship to the spring semester, but decided fall championship was best option.
2. Coaches discussed two issues/concerns surrounding PSAC championships:
 - * Pace of Play – The Games committee and USGA officials will make this a point of emphasis at the championship site.
 - * Transportation between venues is a concern for teams who travel together – PSAC office will contact Hershey to see if the start times could be staggered – no objections from the group.
3. Reviewed Operating code – coaches requested the changes (in red) below.

2.1.1 Uniforms: Contestants must wear uniforms of the same color during competition or practice. Walking or Bermuda shorts, **skorts and pants** are permitted, provided they are team shorts and are of the same color. Slacks, **skorts or** shorts may be worn at the individual's discretion, provided they are of the same color and are considered the team uniform. If a student-athlete wears headgear during competition, it must display only an institutional, conference or NCAA logo, or no logo. If there is no logo, a coach's or team member's headgear must be of an institutional color. A manufacturer's logo may appear on the side or back of the item, as long as it conforms to NCAA Bylaw 12.5.5.

2.3.3 Spectators: Spectators should remain on cart paths or in the rough, and approximately ~~15~~ **20** yards from players. There may be no communication between players and spectators that could be deemed advice of any nature. All institutional personnel, excluding designated coach, are considered spectators.
