

**PSAC Wrestling Call
Meeting Notes
2/13/2012**

Schools represented on call: Bloomsburg, Clarion, East Stroudsburg, Edinboro, Gannon, Kutztown, Lock Haven, Mercyhurst, Shippensburg

Also on call: Bruce Baumgartner, PSAC wrestling liaison, and Steve Murray, PSAC Commissioner

Discussion occurred concerning six Division II institutions constitute a conference. The PSAC can receive funding for a Division II Championship if the PSAC declared a Division II PSAC Championship. NCAA did not care if it is dual or individual championship.

Discussion occurred concerning DI and DII institutions competing at the individual championships. The coaches were in favor of keeping the individual championship in early December with all 10 schools competing. Unanimous vote.

The coaches decided that for 2012-13, the PSAC would declare its “champion” based on the W-L record of the six Division II teams in dual meet scheduling. The DII coaches felt that at least for the 2012-13 academic year that they would take it upon themselves to schedule the required five dual meet matches with the other member institutions.

The DII coaches will schedule each other in at least one dual match per year among the Division II members. If more than one dual match ends up being scheduled between programs, we will discuss the issue between the conference office and the involved schools as to which match will “count” in the conference standings, unless the institutions mutually agree in advance. There is already a great deal of the D II schools that dual each other. Unanimous Vote.

The administration and coaches believe this is in the best long-term interest of the sport of wrestling in the PSAC.
